6. Age Groups:

We have moved over to the odd age groups to be more in line with the other LFA's. According to the SAFA Constitution, it works according to the players age on 1 January.

U7 - 2018 -2017

U9 - 2016 -2015

U11 - 2014 - 2013

U13 - 2012 - 2011

U15 - 2010 - 2009

U17 - 2008 - 2007

U19 - 2006 - 2005

Keeping in line with SAFA and the requirements for Women's Football, we will be piloting U15 and U17 Girls' Leagues this season. All girls from 2012 to 2009 will be registered under their own U15 league and 2008 to 2007 will be registered under their own U17 league on MYSAFA. The requirements from SAFA are that each club must have a girls' team. Their league will run congruently alongside the boys' league. Girls U9 and U11: if you have a full team of girls, you can enter them into a league 2 years younger. In other words, an U11 girls' team will play in the U9 league. We encourage the clubs to approach the schools in their area for girls

as there are a lot of girls that wish to play but up until now there has been no league for them. Mrs. Jennings and Charné will be visiting the schools as well to help the clubs in this regard. If clubs can get older ladies and form a senior team that would also be welcome. We would really encourage the Clubs to try and get a Senior Ladies together as we intend to start a League for Senior Ladies as well!

7. Please read through the attached Document with directives set out by SAFA with regards to having junior teams. Please try to adhere to these directives if it is applicable to you as a Club.

We will be holding a Junior Club meeting on 18 March 2024, whereby we will be covering all issues and rules and regulations with regards to the juniors.
